## APPLICANT/PARENT COMMITMENT CONTRACT

- 1. <u>Income Necessity</u>. Each case will be evaluated separately by Delian Music. We must have a copy of the first two pages of your last two years tax returns and a payroll receipt stub.
- 2. <u>Commitment.</u> Both student and parent must show commitment to this program by reading and agreeing to the student enrollment form.
- 3. Evaluation. Delian Music will evaluate from time to time the student's progress
- 4. <u>Transportation</u>. Must be provided by the parent/guardian to Delian Music.
- 5. <u>Instruments/Books</u>. Each student must have an instrument to practice on at home during the week. Delian Music has very affordable instruments for purchase. Student must purchase the books that the teacher requires for the lessons. In some cases, the scholarship may have enough funds to provide lesson books and/or the instrument; if that is the case the instruments will remain the property of Delian Music; no stickers, painting, carving, etc will be allowed to change the appearance of the instrument and case; if instrument is lost, damaged or stolen, parent and/or guardian is responsible for purchasing said item;
- 6. <u>Attendance.</u> It is mandatory that the student attend all scheduled music lessons. A 24-hour notice must be given to Delian Music when a child cannot attend. Missing more than one lesson a quarter may result in immediate termination of the program.
- 7. <u>Teachers</u>. Any concerns or questions about the teacher must be directed to Delian Music immediately so that we can fix the situation. Sometimes it just isn't a good fit between student and teacher. We have many teachers to choose from.
- 8. <u>Fund(s)</u>. Delian Music has the right to postpone lessons when fund are not available.
- 9. <u>Recitals.</u> Students are required to perform in recitals and all monies raised at this event are donated to the Delian Music Education Fund.
- 10. Age Requirement. Children 18 years and younger.
